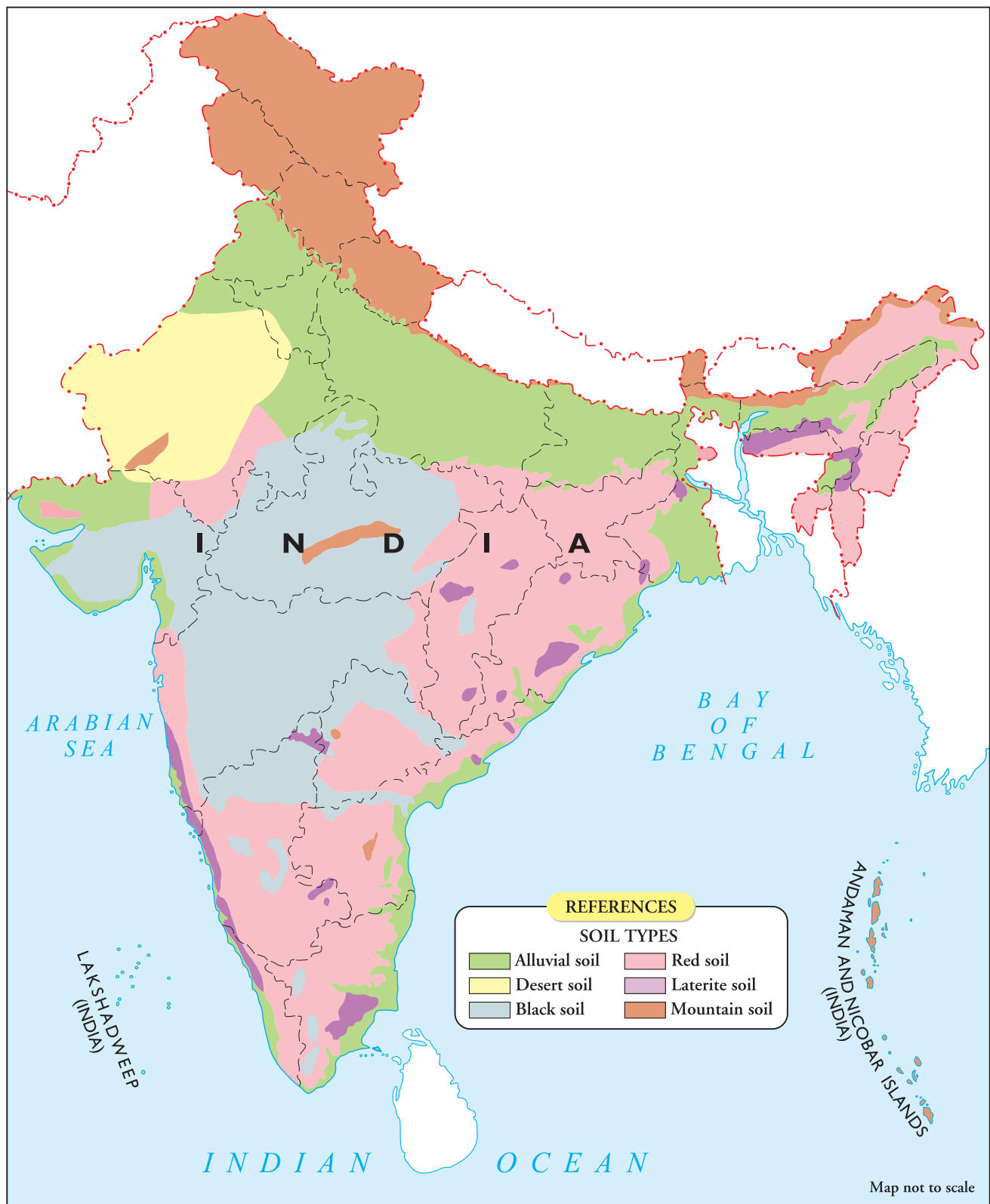

major software technology parks in India

LAHORE NON-COOPERATION
Students walked out en masse from colleges at Lala Lajpat Rai's call in January 1921.

LAHORE
Brutal lathi charge by the police during anti-Simon Commission protest, led to the death of Lala Lajpat Rai on 30 October 1928.

LAHORE CONSPIRACY CASE
Bhagat Singh and Batukeshwar Dutt threw a bomb in the Central Legislative Assembly Hall to protest against the hanging of the accused Ram Prasad Bismil and Ashfaqulla Khan in the Kakori Conspiracy Case.

LAHORE CONGRESS SESSION
Held in 1929, presided over by Pandit Nehru, to launch the Civil Disobedience Movement – Poorna Swaraj was declared – decision taken to celebrate 26 January as Independence Day. National Flag was hoisted on 26 January 1930.

JALLIANWALLA BAGH
Witnessed the worst ever massacre by a country's army on the unarmed innocent people, collected for a peaceful protest against the Rowlatt Act, on Baisakhi day, 13 April 1919 in Amritsar. The massacre was ordered by General Dyer and left thousands dead and wounded.

DELHI
Protests and demonstrations against the Rowlatt Act saw a memorable rally in Delhi after police firing near the Railway Station and Chandni Chowk. The rally displayed great Hindu-Muslim unity.

DELHI
The last popular upsurge before independence was the result of a trial of 3 officers of INA for conspiring against the British Empire. The trial took place at the Red Fort in November 1945.

CHAMPAUR
Indigo revolt by cultivators began in 1917. First Satyagraha by Mahatma Gandhi.

CHAURI CHAURA
In February 1922 police opened fire on a procession of Congress and Khilafat members, resulting in the burning down of the police station and the death of 22 policemen, making Gandhiji withdraw the Non-Cooperation Movement.

MANIPUR
The INA under Subhash Chandra Bose, captured 10,000 sq. miles of land in Manipur, which was a big defeat for the British forces. The INA took over Imphal though the British were winning the World War practically all over the world.

KAHORI
A train was held up by ten revolutionaries at Kahori near Lucknow and was robbed of the official railway cash on 9 August 1925. Ashfaqulla Khan, Roshan Singh, Ram Prasad Bismil and Rajendra Lahiri were hanged for the crime while Chandra Shekhar Azad escaped.

BAHMEHABAD
Sabarmati Ashram was established in January 1915. On 15 March 1918 Gandhiji used his weapon of hunger strike for the first time in the conflict between Gujarat mill owners and their workers.

DANDI
A 200-mile march in 24 days across Gujarat to make salt on the beach at Dandi. (12-26 March 1930)

BAHMEHABAD
The British move to try the INA freedom fighters led to large-scale demonstrations. The great Bombay naval strike of February 1946 is considered as one of the most important reasons why the British quit India.

BAHMEHABAD
The Congress Session in August 1942 passed the famous 'Quit India Resolution'. By the end of 1943 large-scale arrests were made all over India with the highest figure of 24,416 coming from the Bombay Presidency.

BAHMEHABAD
The Naval Mutiny that began in Bombay on 18 February, spread all over the country by 22 February 1946 with Madras and Karachi being other important centres.

BAHMEHABAD
C. Rajagopalachari established his headquarters in Tiruchengodu Ashram in 1925 to spearhead the movement from the South. Rajaji marched from Trichinopoly to Vedaranniyam on the coast to break the Salt Law in April 1930.

BAHMEHABAD
To promote Swadeshi goods, V.O. Chidambaram Pillai started a weaving factory and a cooperative society. The British tried him for treason.

ANDAMAN AND NICOBAR ISLANDS
The INA freed these islands and renamed them as Swaraj and Shaheed Islands.
